

Minutes of Regular Session

1. **Call to order:** Robin Reid Village President called the board meeting to order at 7:00 pm.

3. **Approve Minutes:** Motion by Bédard to approve the minutes of the February 25, 2026 Regular Board Meeting as presented. Seconded by Barta. Voice vote. Motion carried.
4. **Review and approve agenda:** Motion by Saperstein to approve the agenda as presented. Seconded by Miller. Voice vote. Motion carried.
5. **Consent agenda:** Motion by McCarville to approve the consent agenda consisting of the following:

6. **Old Business:**
 - a. Discussion and possible action regarding Project Cost Estimates for WWTF Upgrades and preliminary sewer utility rates. After reviewing the User Rate Analysis provided by Greg Droessler of Town & Country Engineering, Inc., the Village Board came to a consensus to move forward with the two times fixed fee option.  - b. Discussion and possible action regarding Well House #3 Bid Proposal Form & Advertisement for Bids. Motion by Saperstein to accept and approve authorizing for Well House #3 Bid Proposal Form & Advertisement for Bids as presented. Seconded by Miller. Voice vote. Motion carried.
 - c. Discussion and possible action regarding proposed implementation of a Village Room Tax. Reid asked the Village Board to research the implementation of a Village Room Tax. No additional action taken.
8. **General Public Comment:** Cole Rasmussen shared concerns regarding the implementation of a Village Room Tax on an already struggling industry and encouraged the Village Board to talk to those who will be impacted by this tax. He also suggested reaching out to like-sized communities with similar tourism concerns for suggestions that will benefit all businesses, not just one big one. Daniel Carlson, Carolina Dursina, and others in attendance stated that they agreed with Rasmussen.
