

Minutes of Regular Session
Proceedings of the Village of Spring Green Board of Trustees
May 27, 2026 – 7:00 pm
Meeting held in-person or via Zoom & Teleconference

1. **Call to order:** Robin Reid Village President called the board meeting to order at 7:01 pm.
2. **Roll call of Village Board members:** Robin Reid, Hope Winship, Deb Miller, Jean-Claude Bédard, Damian Barta, Jeannie McCarville, and David Saperstein. Also, present: Wendy Crary, Frank Glynn, Vikki Stingley, and Village Attorney Eric Hagen - Boardman Clark. Via Zoom & Teleconference: Joe Block-Independent Star News, and Valley Sentinel Notetaker.
3. **Approve Minutes:** Motion by Barta to approve the minutes of the May 13, 2026 Regular Board Meeting with the stated addition of “Madison Street” to the address in “Old Business: 5.a.” as stated. Seconded by Saperstein. Voice vote. Motion carried.
4. **Review and approve agenda:** Motion by Miller to approve the agenda as presented. Seconded by Bédard. Voice vote. Motion carried.
5. **Old Business:**
 - a. Discussion and possible action regarding update on abatement of property located at 433 W. Madison Street. Glynn gave a brief update; asking the Village Board to consider removing the raise order so he might secure a loan to finish the repairs needed. The Village Board asked Glynn to attend the next two meetings due to the approaching deadline of July 1, 2026. Glynn agreed.
6. **New Business:**
 - a. Approval of Disbursements. Motion by Miller to approve the disbursements as presented. Seconded by Barta. Voice vote. Motion carried.
7. **General Public Comment:** No public comment.
8. **Convene into closed session:** At 7:17 pm Reid motioned to go into closed session under Section 19.85(1)(g) of the Wisconsin Statutes for “Conferring with legal counsel for the governmental body who is rendering oral or written advice concerning strategy to be adopted by the body with respect to litigation in which it is or is likely to become involved.” Seconded by Miller. Roll call vote aye: Bédard, Saperstein, Winship, Barta, McCarville, Miller, and Reid Aye 7, Nay 0. Motion carried.
9. **Reconvene into open session:** Miller moved, and Winship seconded to reconvene into open session at 8:27 pm. Voice vote. Motion carried.
 - a. Discussion and possible action regarding guidance from Village Attorney specifically related to abatement of property located at 433 W. Madison Street. No action taken.
10. **General Public Comment:** No public comment.
11. **Adjourn:** Motion by Bédard to adjourn at 8:28 pm. Seconded by Saperstein. Voice vote. Motion carried.
