

Minutes of Regular Session
Proceedings of the Village of Spring Green Board of Trustees
July 8, 2026 – 7:00 pm
Meeting held in-person or via Zoom & Teleconference

1. **Call to order:** Robin Reid Village President called the board meeting to order at 7:00 pm.
2. **Roll call of Village Board members:** Robin Reid, Hope Winship, Deb Miller, Jean-Claude Bédard, Jeannie McCarville, and Damian Barta 7:05 pm. Absent: David Saperstein. Also, present: Wendy Crary, Frank Glynn, Ray Johnson, and Vikki Stingley. Via Zoom & Teleconference: Joe Block-Independent Star News, and Valley Sentinel Notetaker.
3. **Approve Minutes:** Motion by Bédard to approve the minutes of the June 24, 2026 Regular Board Meeting as presented. Seconded by Winship. Voice vote. Motion carried.
4. **Review and approve agenda:** Motion by Miller to approve the agenda as presented. Seconded by McCarville. Voice vote. Motion carried.
5. **Consent agenda:** Reid request that Consent agenda 5. e. “Approval of a request submitted by Darby Blakley – RVHS Principal to have a fireworks display on Thursday, September 24th, and to have a Homecoming Parade on the streets of Spring Green on Friday, September 25th.” be removed.
Motion by Miller to approve the consent agenda consisting of the following:
 - a. Approval of Disbursements.
 - b. Approval of the Following License for St. John’s Funfest, Veterans Park Baseball Field/Daley St (between Park Dr & N Worcester St), Spring Green, WI 53588
 - (1) Temporary Class “B”/ “Class B” Retailer’s License for 8/7/2026 -8/9/2026.
 - c. Approval of an Operator’s License for Kymberly Lund, Spring Green, WI.
 - d. Approval of an Operator’s License for Pamela Miles, Spring Green, WI.Seconded by Winship. Voice vote. Motion carried.
Reid expressed concerns about candy being thrown from floats or motorized vehicles. Motion by Winship to approve Consent agenda 5. e. “Approval of a request submitted by Darby Blakley – RVHS Principal to have a fireworks display on Thursday, September 24th, and to have a Homecoming Parade on the streets of Spring Green on Friday, September 25th.” contingent on some sort of understanding that float entries are not to throw candy. Seconded by Miller. Voice vote. Motion carried.
6. **Information Items:**

7. **General Public Comment:** No public comment.
8. **Convene into closed session:** At 7:08pm Reid motioned to go into closed session under Section 19.85(1)(g) of the Wisconsin Statutes for “Conferring with legal counsel for the governmental body who is rendering oral or written advice concerning strategy to be adopted by the body with respect to litigation in which it is or is likely to become involved.” Seconded by Winship. Roll call vote aye: Bédard, Winship, Barta, McCarville, Miller, and Reid Aye 6, - Nay 0. Saperstein was absent. Motion carried.
9. **Reconvene into open session:** Miller moved, and Winship seconded to reconvene into open session at 7:19 pm. Voice vote. Motion carried.
 - a. Discussion and possible action regarding guidance from Village Attorney specifically related to abatement of property located at 433 W. Madison Street. No action taken.
