SWIMMING POOL RULES AND REGULATIONS

- Sign in at the front desk, emergency contact number needed, Season Pass or daily fee must be paid.
- Due to liability coverage, everyone entering the pool must pay admission, even if they are not planning on swimming or getting into the water.
- Shower before using pool and after using restrooms.
- Swimwear is required for all users, and nudity is not permitted in locker rooms, showers, or public areas.
- Swim diapers are required for swimmers not bathroom trained.
- Diaper changing in the pool area is prohibited. Please use locker rooms.
- Children must be at least 8 years old AND have the ability of a Level 3 swimmer to be at the pool without adult supervision. (If you are unsure of what level or swimming ability your child is, a swim test will be conducted verifying the child is able to swim one length of the pool without touching and a one-minute tread/float.)
- Foul/inappropriate language is prohibited.
- No running, pushing, splashing, dunking, drinking or engage in rough play in the pool area or locker rooms.
- No open cuts, sores, rashes, infections, or contagious diseases are allowed in the pool area.
- No pets/animals into the pool area.
- No food, drink, gum, smoking/vaping/tobacco, alcohol, or other drugs into the pool area
- No older kids in the wading pool
- No hanging or sitting on boards, buoyed lines, ladders, or lane markers Lap Lane is for lap swimmers only.
- Glass and shatterable items are prohibited in the pool area.
- No one should be in the lifeguard chairs except the lifeguards.
- Patrons should not engage in unnecessary/inappropriate conversation with the lifeguards, as their major responsibility is the surveillance of swimmers.
- The pool phone is for emergency use only.
- Cell phone use or any videotaping in locker rooms or restrooms is prohibited.
- Any other behavior that is felt unsafe or inappropriate will be prohibited.

The Pool Manager/Staff retain the right to ask patrons to exit the facility if they are not abiding by pool rules; and passes may be revoked for the season.
